**VINIFICATION:** Red grapes are fermented as white grapes for rosé at 16 °C. After fermentation takes place, the wine is dealcoholized by physical process (spinning cone).

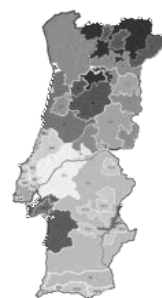
