Owned by the winemaker Domingos Soares Franco, Camarate hosts a collection of unique grape varieties with around 560 national and international varieties. Produced from the Arinto and Fernão Pires grape varieties, Vinhas de Camarate White presents a fruity aroma of peach and pineapple that is well integrated with wood spices, a very fresh acidity and a delicate but present minerality.

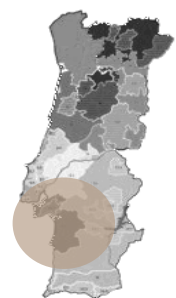
